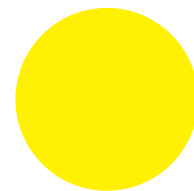

Backpacking Around the World in 44 days - a Celebration of Diversity

Week 1

June 1-4

"Our World"

We will understand the bigger picture. We will each make a papier mache globe, a passport, learn about the Seven Wonders, and study the animals of the continents.

Week 2

June 7-11

"North America"

We will get our passports stamped while visiting Niagara Falls (USA), Aztec Temple in Tenochtitlan (Mexico City), and the Panama Canal among others. We will read works from Leo Politi and Alikei.

Week 3

June 14-18

"South America"

We will immerse ourselves in the Spanish culture while visiting rainforests, Angel Falls and Machu Pichu (Peru). We will make quesadillas and Argentina butter cookies. We will read The Great Kapok Tree.

Week 4

June 21-25

"My Country 'Tis of Thee"

Wear red, white, and blue this week as we make a pit-stop back home and make a book of US monuments, learn the Pledge of Allegiance, sing the National Anthem, make a replica of the Washington Monument, and study the bald eagle.

Week 5

June 28 - July 2

"Europe"

Our journey continues as we stop by the Leaning Tower of Pisa (Italy), Stonehenge (England), the Statue of Zeus (Greece), the Temple of Artemis (Turkey). We will sing in French and learn some ballet steps.

July 12-16

"Asia"

We will learn how to count in Chinese and Farsi while visiting the Great Wall of China, the Hanging Gardens of Babylon & the Throne Hall of Persepolis (Iran), and the Taj Mahal (India).

Our safari across this continent will allow us to see the Three Great Pyramids (Cairo), the Lighthouse of Alexandria, and Victoria Falls. We will read Why Mosquitoes Buzz in People's Ears and Anansi.

Week 9

July 26-30

"Oceania and Antarctica"

The last stop on our journey will teach us about the four families of the orchestra as we get our tickets ready to visit the Sydney Opera House (Australia). We will also learn about Kangaroos and Polar Bears.

Week 10

August 2-6

"Serving Our World"
